- the implementation of all such things as are incidental or conducive to the attainment of the above projects.

B. to distribute the funds pursuant to the aforesaid objects, provided that such funds shall be distributed by its agents to the people of the Solu Khumbu region of Nepal and that the Canadian origin of such aid is made known at the point of distribution.

C. To accept donations, gifts, legacies and bequests for use in promoting the above objects and carrying on the work of the Foundation.

D. To invest undistributed funds of the Foundation in investments authorized for the investment of trust fund.
